VINEYARD REGION	<i>South Eastern Australia</i>
VINTAGE CONDITIONS	<i>A mild winter led to a warm, dry growing season with early bud burst. It was relatively cool leading into an early vintage. From mid-January it remained dry and became relatively hot, accelerating ripening. Healthy leaf canopies protected the fruit, while rain and cooler weather in mid-February slowed down harvesting, with 2014 ultimately proving to be another good vintage.</i>

MATURATION	<i>4 months maturation with French oak.</i>

PALATE	<i>A medium bodied, juicy palate with upfront flavours of blackcurrants and raspberries supported by gentle vanillin oak and following through to a soft tannin finish.</i>
