VINTAGE CONDITIONS	<i>Good winter rainfall, warm conditions in early November and a cool summer all contributed to excellent flavour development and the retention of natural acidity.</i>
GRAPE VARIETY	<i>Chardonnay</i>
MATURATION	<i>The wine was barrel fermented in a combination of seasoned and new French oak barrels for six months.</i>
WINE ANALYSIS	<i>Alc/Vol: 13.5%</i> <i>Acidity: 5.5g/L</i> <i>pH: 3.38</i>
PEAK DRINKING	<i>This wine will develop further complexities over the next three to five years.</i>

NOSE	<i>Rich with aromas of grapefruit and white peach with a subtle nutty oak influence.</i>
PALATE	<i>Full yet elegant with varietal chardonnay flavours and complex creamy texture with a fine refreshing acid line that give it a long and delicate finish.</i>
