VINEYARD REGION	<i>Adelaide Hills</i>
VINTAGE CONDITIONS	<i>Drought conditions resulted in low yields and early ripening. The season remained dry throughout ripening allowing for optimum maturity to be reached and distinct varietal flavours to develop.</i> <i>The Adelaide Hills rise to 400m and are cooler in summer than neighbouring regions. The low yielding vines were pruned and trained to achieve maximum sunlight exposure through the vertical positioning of shoots.</i>

MATURATION	<i>This wine was matured for nine months in French oak barrels.</i>
WINE ANALYSIS	<i>Alc/Vol: 14.00%</i> <i>Acidity: 5.5g/L</i> <i>pH: 3.73</i>
PEAK DRINKING	<i>This wine is enjoyable now but will reward 2-3 years cellaring.</i>
