VINEYARD REGION	<i>South Eastern Australia</i>
VINTAGE CONDITIONS	<i>A warm, dry start to the season brought on rapid, early flowering. After a much-needed rain in January, summer progressed with warm days and relatively cool nights, perfect for ripening. A burst of heat in late January brought on an early, condensed harvest with wines full of flavour and with good natural balance.</i>
GRAPE VARIETY	<i>Cabernet Sauvignon</i>
MATURATION	<i>Predominantly matured in stainless steel, with a touch of French oak to enhance complexity while maintaining the fresh fruit flavours.</i>
WINE ANALYSIS	<i>Alc/Vol: 13.5% Acidity: 6.0 g/L pH: 3.65</i>
PEAK DRINKING	<i>Best enjoyed in its youth, however will continue to develop for 1 to 2 years in bottle.</i>
FOOD MATCH	<i>Great served with spaghetti Bolognese or grilled lamb cutlets with rosemary potatoes.</i>

COLOUR	<i>Dark purple with a crimson rim.</i>
NOSE	<i>Notes of blueberry and plum with a hint of leafy Cabernet character.</i>
PALATE	<i>Dense plummy fruit dominates the palate and is supported by fine Cabernet fruit tannins and a small amount of oak, creating a soft, plush wine with great drinkability while still retaining varietal character.</i>
