





VINEYARD REGION	<i>South Eastern Australia</i>
VINTAGE CONDITIONS	<i>A wet winter was followed by a windy, cooler and wetter than average spring. Along with cool nights in early summer, this markedly slowed ripening and delayed harvest by about 4 weeks. Hot weather in mid February and early March progressed ripening, after which nights were cool through to end of harvest. Overall wine quality was good, with bright fruit freshness.</i>
GRAPE VARIETY	<i>Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon</i>
MATURATION	<i>Matured with 60% American and 40% French oak for four months to add complexity and enhance palate structure.</i>
WINE ANALYSIS	<i>Alc/Vol: 13.5% Acidity: 6.0 g/L pH: 3.56 Residual sugar: 4.4 g/L</i>
PEAK DRINKING	<i>Best enjoyed in its youth.</i>
FOOD MATCH	<i>Great with Moroccan lamb tajine with saffron and chickpeas, or chorizo and roast vegetable pizza.</i>

COLOUR	<i>Bright purple with red hues.</i>
NOSE	<i>Bright, juicy aromas of plum, redcurrant and red berries, with subtle hints of oak.</i>
PALATE	<i>A medium-bodied, easy-drinking wine with plenty of juicy, red berry flavours, and a smooth, rounded palate with a soft tannin finish.</i>
