VINTAGE CONDITIONS	<i>Heavy rains in February had minimal impact and were followed by mild conditions leading up to harvest, with sunny days and cool nights helping retain aromatics and acidity. As a result, fruit quality was very good, displaying vibrant, concentrated flavours.</i>
GRAPE VARIETY	<i>64% Cabernet Sauvignon – 36% Merlot</i>
MATURATION	<i>Matured with the subtle use of French oak to produce a balanced, integrated wine.</i>
WINE ANALYSIS	<i>Alc/Vol: 13.5% Acidity: 6.7 g/L pH: 3.40</i>
PEAK DRINKING	<i>Enjoy in its youth to savour the fresh fruit flavours.</i>
FOOD MATCH	<i>Great with pork tenderloin with Dijon mushrooms or spaghetti carbonara.</i>

COLOUR	<i>Vibrant red with purple hues.</i>
NOSE	<i>Lifted varietal characters of blackcurrant, mint and raspberry with a hint of spicy oak.</i>
PALATE	<i>A medium-bodied wine with an array of red and dark berry fruits supported by a soft tannin structure, making the wine immediately approachable.</i>
