VINEYARD REGION	<i>South Australia</i>
VINTAGE CONDITIONS	<i>The 2011 Vintage was challenging due to high summer rainfall and a cool growing season throughout South Australia. Careful vineyard selection was crucial in maintaining quality in a year with higher disease pressure. The cooler conditions acted to maintain excellent acid levels in both reds and whites, with bright, vibrant wines resulting.</i>
GRAPE VARIETY	<i>Cabernet Sauvignon</i>
MATURATION	<i>Parcels of this wine were matured with French and American oak.</i>
WINE ANALYSIS	<i>Alc/Vol: 13.5%</i> <i>Acidity: 6.3g/L</i> <i>pH: 3.58</i>
PEAK DRINKING	<i>Enjoy this wine in its youth or cellar correctly for three to five years.</i>

PALATE	<i>Generous mid palate with plum and cassis overtones, subtle integrated oak, gently structured tannins and a finely textured finish.</i>
