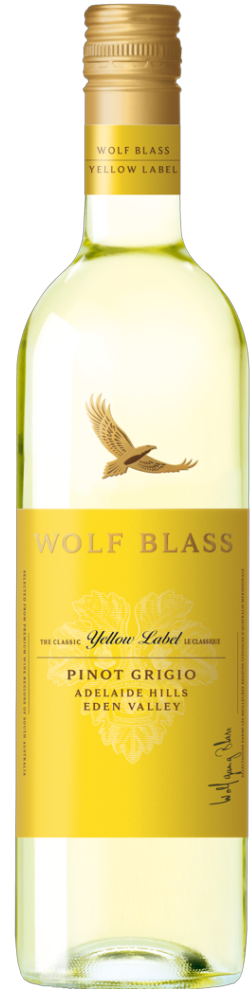

VINEYARD REGION	<i>Adelaide Hills, Eden Valley</i>
VINTAGE CONDITIONS	<i>Above average winter rainfall set up the growing season with optimal soil moisture. Spring was cool and wet, with good conditions during late flowering. Cool weather continued into summer, with mostly moderate conditions remaining right through to a delayed harvest, maintaining vine balance, extending ripening, and ensuring excellent aroma and flavour development.</i>
GRAPE VARIETY	<i>Pinot Grigio</i>
MATURATION	<i>Matured in stainless steel tanks to preserve fruit characters and varietal purity.</i>
WINE ANALYSIS	<i>Alc/Vol: 12.5% Acidity: 6.8 g/L pH: 3.26 Residual sugar: 0.5 g/L</i>
PEAK DRINKING	<i>Best enjoyed while young and fresh.</i>

PALATE	<i>Flavours of ripe fruit and fresh honey on the mid-palate complement the citrus notes and smooth, mineral texture. An aromatic wine with a clean palate and crisp, refreshing finish.</i>
